There will be an UCW Sunshine unit meeting on June 8th from 1:30-3:30 in the Choir room.

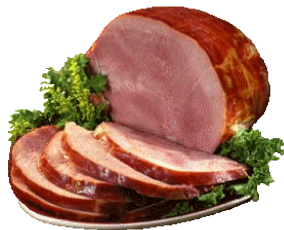
Worship & Picnic in the Park!

If you were unable to have your photo taken but still want to, we have the fortunate opportunity to have our portraits taken at St Anthony's Church, June 7-11.

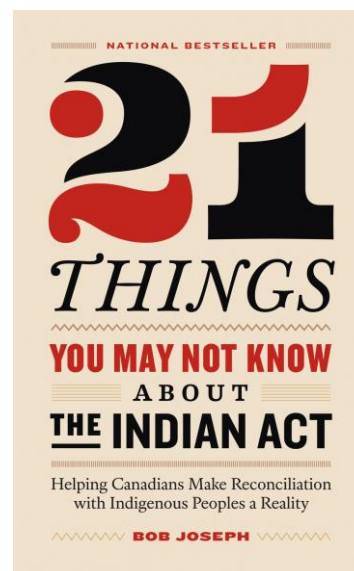

AFFIRMING DIVERSITY WORSHIP SERVICE

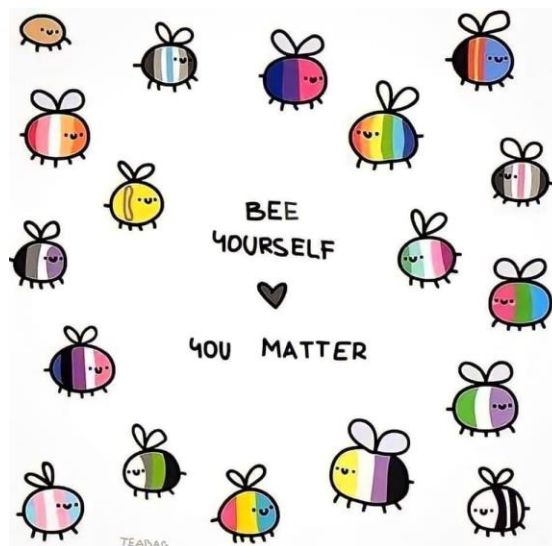
