### **FOOD BANK DONATIONS**

Kincardine United Church has a long history of supporting the Kincardine Food Bank. Prior to the Covid Pandemic we would collect food items on the last Sunday of each month, bless those donations and deliver them to the Food Bank.



Since the beginning of the pandemic, almost a year ago, we have been unable to collect food items. In 2020 cash donations were made through the Church amounting to \$790.00. This amount was raised without any reminder of the need for food in our community.
