We need volunteers willing to staff the nursery as well as volunteers to staff Fellowship Hall gatherings while checking **proof of vaccination for those gathering.**

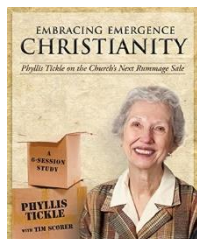
