VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN: A TIME FOR REMEMBRANCE, AWARENESS AND ACTION



Join us on Monday, December 6th between 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. for a vigil which will be both in-person and online. Pay respect to the 14 women murdered at École Polytechnique, Montreal in 1989. Pay respect to the women murdered this year by their intimate partners. Pay respect to the women victimized this year by femicide. Take the time to raise awareness about issues affecting women in abusive relationships, teaching us how to become allies of safety in their lives. May this vigil move us to action, leading to our becoming advocates for safety and for justice for all women. There will be no sermon. A safe space of quiet reflection will be created while contemplative music plays. Information, insights, tributes and memorials will be scrolled on the screens. 14 roses will represent the women murdered in 1989.

please indicate your donation is for Tech Special Project.

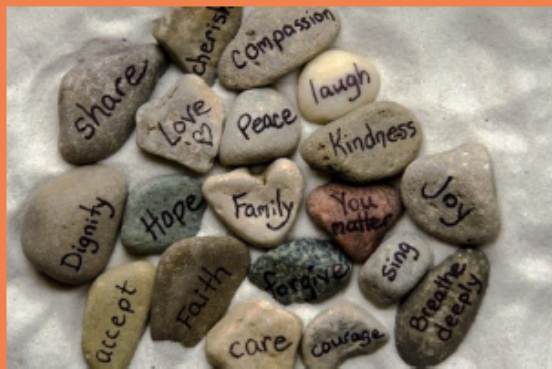
