Council has approved a \$9,000 Special Project to do Hybrid Worship



At the present time the equipment for the in-person worship does not talk to the equipment for the on-line worship. For the systems to talk to each other, for those in the sanctuary to view and hear videos, and for those on-line to see better we need to merge our two systems together so we need to do a minor upgrade. We now have a Tech Special Project to do just that. If you wish to donate to this Special Project,

VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN: A TIME FOR REMEMBRANCE, AWARENESS AND ACTION



Join us on **Monday, December 6th between 7:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m.** for a vigil which will be both in-person and online. Pay respect to the 14 women murdered at École Polytechnique, Montreal in 1989. Pay respect to the women murdered this year by their intimate partners. Pay respect to the women victimized this year by femicide. Take the time to raise awareness about issues affecting women in abusive relationships,

teaching us how to become allies of safety in their lives. May this vigil move us to action, leading to our becoming advocates for safety and for justice for all women. There will be no sermon. A safe space of quiet reflection will be created while contemplative music plays. Information, insights, tributes and memorials will be scrolled on the screens. 14 roses will represent the women murdered in 1989.
