This amount includes applicable taxes. If you renew on your own, the group rate would not apply. The Broadview Office sends out annual "Friends of Broadview" requests. Please be advised these requests are not for subscriptions but are an extra donation.

Payment Options:

1. **Mail your payment to the church - 721 Princes St. North Kincardine ON N2Z 2A3. *Write cheques out to "Kincardine United Church" and put "Broadview" in the memo. (Your cheque needs to be received here at our office by Tuesday, December 5th.)**
 2. **Online payment** - Observer/Broadview subscription payments can be made through Kincardine United Church using our "new" **Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT)**. Details can be found on our KUC website: <http://www.kincardineunitedchurch.org/content/e-transfers>

- Make your online payment by **Tuesday, December 5th.***
3. **Put your payment on the plate by Dec. 2th** (indicate that it is for Broadview)
 4. **Bring your payment to the church during office hours by Dec. 5th**

HOME AT LAST 'HAL'

A Program to support aging, frail adults or people with special needs to settle at home upon discharge from hospital

The secret ingredient of this service is the personal attention given. On discharge day, a HAL attendant will meet the patient in their room, support them through the discharge process and escort them to their home, in an accessible van. Once settled, the attendant can assist with errands such as grocery, prescription or medical equipment pickup, if required.

There is **no fee** for services provided by HAL, however the client will be responsible to pay for pharmacy costs and/or groceries.

The attendant ensures the client is safe and comfortable, providing Home Management.

Our HAL program also includes a next day telephone reassurance call, a complimentary 'Meals on Wheels' meal and more follow-up calls from HAL staff.
