

AFGHANISTAN FAMILY APPROVED AND NEEDS YOUR HELP



Earlier this year, The Kincardine Refugee Committee heard of an Afghan family hiding in Pakistan. They have told us the most heartbreaking story of threats and persecution and they are desperate to find safety in another country. Their situation has become even more dire, as they risk being sent back to Afghanistan if their visa in Pakistan expires before they can get to safety. They are traumatized and in need of a safe place far from the reach of the Taliban. Since we have started communicating, the family has been interviewed by UNHCR (United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees) and approved for refugee status. They have also been checked by IRCC (Immigration Refugees and Citizenship Canada) and given the status of

vulnerable people who qualify for OAS (Operation Afghan Safety) which means that we have the opportunity to sponsor them as a group in an expedited way.

The family consists of a mother, daughter (19), son (16), daughter (12), as well as another 24-year-old daughter who is currently hiding in Turkey. Because this family qualifies under OAS

they will hopefully be with us faster than a normal sponsorship. As a result, we are undertaking an urgent fundraising program. Funds will be supporting a family of 5 who will need housing, and who will be coming with nothing. It will take substantial funds, there being no financial support available from the federal government under this program.

You can donate toward getting them to Kincardine as a place of safety by donating to the church and marking your donations "Afghan Refugees."
