We recall the family ties that were broken because of forced separation, the tears that were shed, the bitterness caused, and the hurts that continue. Let us pause to remember the ways we continue in our world to treat others based on the financial profit we can derive from them: the persons who work in poor conditions and who are underpaid, the children who are forced to work and receive less than minimum wage, the migrant workers who are exploited.
