# **ASSURANCE OF GRACE**

# GOD SPEAKS TO US IN WORD

#### BIBLE READING Isaiah 42: 1 - 9

- 1. Here is my chosen servant, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul delights; I have put my spirit upon him; he will bring forth justice to the nations.
- 2. He will not cry or lift up his voice or make it heard in the street;
- 3. a bruised reed he will not break, and a dimly burning wick he will not quench; he will faithfully bring forth justice.
- 4. He will not grow faint or be crushed until he has established justice in the earth; and the coastlands wait for his teaching.
- 5. Thus says God, the Lord, who created the heavens and stretched them out, who spread out the earth and what comes from it, who gives breath to the people who walk upon it and spirit to those who walk in it:

- 7. to open the eyes that are blind, to bring out the prisoners from the dungeon, from the prison those who sit in darkness.

- 9. See the former things have come to pass, and new things I now declare; and before they spring forth, I tell you of them.
