ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE LAND

On this Indigenous Day of Prayer, let us acknowledge the traditional land inhabited for thousands of years and cherished by the Indigenous peoples who have lived in this place. We acknowledge that the Saugeen Nation's land is unceded and was to be shared according to Treaty 45 ½.

Let us be mindful of how colonization by European settlers, our ancestors, altered their way of life and scorned their spirituality.

Settlers did not share the land as they were welcomed to do, but encroached upon it, destroying the flora and fauna, polluting the water, and relegating the indigenous people to limited plots of land.

We took their children away and forbade the use of their languages and spiritual practices, separated from the loving family customs they followed at home. The damage caused intergenerational pain and suffering, the effects of which continue to this day.

Help us, we pray oh God, to learn from our mistakes, to commit ourselves to truth and reconciliation with our Indigenous neighbours, valuing them for themselves as we strive for equal justice in our country.
