Welcome

Acknowledgement of the Land

As we begin our worship, this morning, we are mindful that First Nations peoples lived and walked on this land for thousands of years before European settlers arrived on these shores.

The Doctrine of Discovery was a mistaken concept of Western European Empires that justified their taking over territory that had been occupied by Indigenous peoples and that was central to their lives and their deep spirituality.

Settlers had the mistaken belief that they were called to spread the gospel to the peoples they conquered, even if they had to use coercion and force to do so. They forgot that the gospel calls us to love all God's peoples. Our belief led us to ignore the wisdom of those who had inhabited these lands before we came, despite their generous efforts to help us and teach us their ways. We did not respect our obligations under treaties with Indigenous peoples. For this this we are truly sorry.

The United Church of Canada has pledged to walk the long road to reconciliation with the original peoples of our land. We are all treaty people, parties to Crown Treaty 45 ½ in 1836. We acknowledge that we are meeting on the unceded territory of the Saugeen Ojibway nations and the indigenous peoples who preceded them. We are committed to grow into living in respect on this land, walking into reconciliation through peace and friendship, while honouring all peoples who live, work and worship on it.
