## PRESENTATION BY WES LARSEN OF THE DROP-IN AT THE BRIDGE

- Wes is the Executive Director
- The Bridge now as CRA Charitable status
- Drop-in started four years ago as a drop-in for seniors
- Five years ago 22% of the residents in Kincardine were 65 or older, the average income was \$96,000 but 20% lived below the poverty line
- On Monday they provide free lunch for seniors and Community Living residents
- One day a week they provide a free lunch for teens prior to covid they were serving 30-60 kids
- Starting in December they will be holding an open mic night for teens goal is to bring kids into a safe place kids can sing, dance, do a skit, ready poetry etc
- Goal is also to have a place kids can come and do homework and possibly get tutoring
- Would like kids to have their own Council and decide on programs and run them
- Currently running a drop-in every other Friday evening for Ukrainian refugees in the area
- During the pandemic they delivered free meals to approximately 80 people each week, mostly seniors and single parent families
- Also delivered frozen meals during the pandemic and have continued this will reach 5,000 meals delivered in the near future
- Want to reach out to those on the margins or who have no voice
- Currently have 39 volunteers
  - Required to volunteer one day a month (minimum) need a police check for this
  - o If cooking frozen meals provide 10 meals per month
- Also assist people by reviewing all available government programs with new attendees
- Currently paying \$100 a day for rent
- 2022 fall to 2023 fall budget is \$60,000
- In future they will also have to start paying heat and power
- Do a lot of fundraising
- In February doing a large dinner and selling tickets
- What Can We Do Help?
  - o Become a volunteer
  - Raise money through an event
  - Donations

- The Drop-in at the Bridge is NOT supported by the Church there except for hydro and heat and soon that will end
- No worship/conversion being done do say grace on Monday
- They accept people as they are want it to be a safe place for everyone
